FINDING YOUR ADJUSTMENTS

Ryde Adjustable can be adjusted in three different directions. Use only Torx 25 wrench when adjusting. Otherwise, you may damage the screws.

Lateral alignment/pronation

Loosen the screw under the stirrup attachment until the attachment comes loose and you can change its position. Then tighten the screw firmly when you have found the angle that suits you.




Use the same screw as the stirrup leather attachment, only loosen it a bit further until you can rotate the top loop. Then tighten the screw firmly in the position you prefer.

Tread angle

Unscrew the screw by the foot plate, adjust and then tighten the screw firmly at the desired angle.
